Types & structure of speeches

- Direct speech
- Indirect speech

Direct speech: The boy said, " I'm a student of class ten."

Indirect speech: The boy said that he was a student of class ten.



Tools used in speech

Different types of punctuation marks:

1. (“...”) Inverted comma.
2. (,) Comma.
3. (A) Capital letter.
4. (I’m) Apostrophe.
5. (?) Interrogative mark.
6. (!) Exclamatory mark.
7. (.) Full stop.



Structure of a direct speech

Zara said, "I'm from Bangladesh."

- The blue marked words are called 'Reporting verb'
- The red marked words are called 'Reported speech'
- 'Reported speeches' are changed according to the 'Reporting verbs'
