ADB project to build capacity of IT professionals in Bangladesh



Asian Development Bank (ADB) will provide US\$125 million for a project to improve infrastructure of higher educational institutions and build capacity of IT professionals in Bangladesh.

University Grants Commission (UGC) of Bangladesh held a meeting with ADB on the proposed Tertiary Education for Competitiveness in Information Technology (IT) Project at UGC Bhaban on 27 March 2019. Chairman of UGC Professor Abdul Mannan presided over the meeting. Ms Gi Soon Song, in-charge of ADB's Human and Social Development Division led the ADB Mission.

University of Dhaka, BUET, Jessore University of Science and Technology, East West University have been selected in the first phase for the proposed three-year long ADB project.

Professor Mannan expressed his optimism that once implemented the IT project will produce quality graduates in IT Sector and contribute to develop Bangladesh as a mid-level income generating country by 2021.

Interacting Discussion on proposed HEAT project



An interacting discussion on the proposed Higher Education Acceleration and Transformation (HEAT) project was held at UGC auditorium on 05 February 2019. The UGC invited the Vice-Chancellors, renowned educationists, Professors, high officials from UGC, World Bank, representatives from research organizations, industries and other relevant organizations for in-depth discussion on the proposed five-year long HEAT project. Professor Abdul Mannan, Chairman, UGC graced the function as the Chief Guest, while Professor Dr. Mohammad Yousuf Ali Mollah, Member, UGC presided over the meeting and moderated the discussion session. Professor Dr. Dil Afroza Begum, Member, UGC; Professor Dr. Mesbah Uddin Ahmed, Chairman, Bangladesh Accreditation Council; Professor Dr. Mohammad Tamim, Pro Vice-Chancellor, BRAC University; Professor Dr. Muhammed Zafar Iqbal and Dr. Md. Mokhlesur Rahman, Senior Operations Officer, World Bank, among others spoke on the occasion.

The Chairman of UGC noted that World Bank is taking the initiative to finance the HEAT project based on the successes of HEQEP which was completed in December 2018. The main objective of the new project is to capitalize the enabling conditions for teaching-learning, state-of-art research facilities, connectivity already established through HEQEP and bring a significant breakthrough in tertiary education and research through capacity building and enhancing employability of our graduates and establishing a regional network of higher educational institutions.

Almost all the speakers emphasized on proper education from primary to higher education, conducting advanced research, establishing university-industry collaboration, forming multi-disciplinary research team, ensuring good governance in universities, modernizing curriculum, providing research facilities for women

to accelerate the pace and momentum of the country's higher education.

The discussion on HEAT project continued for the second day on 06 February 2019. It was agreed that a modern training center for improving the quality of teachers needs to be established and strengthening of higher education governance must be incorporated in the project. The transformation of UGC into Higher Education Commission and functionalization of Accreditation Council (BAC) also came up for discussion. Suggestion for creating a universal certificate repository for the authentication of degrees and certificates was put forward by many speakers. Other speakers suggested to introduce a uniform admission test for admission into universities.

Conference on Tertiary Education on RMG in Bangladesh



A day-long conference on Formulating Recommendations on Demand Driven Higher Education Needs in Textile and Readymade Garment sector of Bangladesh was held at a city hotel on 14 February 2019. The primary objectives of German Bangladesh Higher Education Network for Sustainable Textiles (HEST) project are to improve quality of education and encouraging applied research and development of capacity of mid-level managers in Textile and RMG Sectors. University Grants Commission (UGC) of Bangladesh in association with German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) jointly organized the workshop. UGC is the implementing authority of the two-year long project.

Mr. Andreas Hartman, Head of Development Cooperation of German Embassy, Dhaka, Professor Dr. Mohammad Yousuf Ali Mollah, Member, UGC, Dr. Md. Khaled, Secretary, UGC

and Rumana Kabir, Representative of DAAD, spoke on the occasion.

Addressing the programme, Mr. Hartman said skilled mid-level managers are pre-requisite for robust and sustainable economic growth in Bangladesh. "Although the industry has been growing tremendously, further growth and sustainable development together with improved working conditions remain a challenge due to the skill gap of the mid-level managers in the industry," he added.

Terming RMG Sector as vital and crucial for socio-economic development of Bangladesh, Professor Yousuf Ali Mollah said this project will help to make the Textile and RMG sector vibrant and help future robust economic growth in Bangladesh. Speakers unanimously agreed that academic programs must be updated and need-based research must be initiated. They were also in the opinion that a teachers' training centre be established and a knowledge sharing platform be formed. It was also suggested that the capacity of mid-level managers needs to be enhanced and a bridge between industry and academia must be encouraged.

The project has been successfully running with 12 universities which includes Ahsanullah University of Science and Technology, Asian University for Women, Bangladesh University of Textiles, BGMEA University of Fashion and Technology, Chittagong University of Engineering and Technology, North South University, Notre Dame University Bangladesh and University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh. Three German Universities are collaborating in this project.

He also noted that a number of Private universities follow Government and UGC's rules and regulations and are providing quality education.

In course of the discussion, the Syndicate Members came up with a number of suggestions which includes, among others, introduction of a ranking system, enhancing monitoring, building good relations with private universities, appointing more UGC nominated members in syndicate, preparing recruitment policy, setting criteria for private university admission, formulating a recruitment policy under UGC and stopping

opening department rather whimsically in many private universities.

Syndicate Members from over 40 private universities took part in the meeting. Director of UGC Private University Division Dr. Fakhru Islam, senior officials from UGC, among others, were present. As per Private University Act 2010, UGC nominates a syndicate member to the 11- member syndicate body.
